

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2924

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “471.168,” and delete “and 471.311”.
- 2 Delete lines 4 through 31 and delete pages 2 through 4 and insert:
- 3 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 471.220 is amended to read:
- 4 “471.220. (1) A brewery license shall allow the manufacture, importation, storage, transportation,
- 5 wholesale sale and distribution to licensees of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission, and the ex-
- 6 port of malt beverages. [*Except as specifically provided in this section, no brewery licensee shall sell*
- 7 *any malt beverages to be consumed on the licensed premises. No brewery licensee shall*] **A brewery**
- 8 **licensee may not** sell within the State of Oregon any beer containing more than six percent alcohol
- 9 by volume. **Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a brewery licensee may not**
- 10 **sell malt beverages for consumption on the licensed premises.**
- 11 “(2) A brewery licensee may:
- 12 “(a) Sell malt beverages brewed on the licensed premises for consumption on the licensed
- 13 premises; and
- 14 “(b) Sell malt beverages brewed on the licensed premises [*and containing not more than eight*
- 15 *percent alcohol by volume*], in quantities of not less than [*five*] **four** gallons, to an unlicensed organ-
- 16 ization, lodge, picnic party or private gathering. [*Such malt beverages shall not be sold by any such*
- 17 *unlicensed group.*] **An unlicensed organization, lodge, picnic party or private gathering may**
- 18 **not resell the malt beverages that a brewery licensee sells under this paragraph.”**
