## **SUMMARY**

[Authorizes hearings under Family Abuse Prevention Act to be held in person or by telephone.] Allows party to file motion requesting permission for appearance of party or witness by telephone or other two-way electronic communication device in Family Abuse Prevention Act proceedings.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 107.700 to
5	107.735.
6	SECTION 2. (1) A party may file a motion under ORS 45.400 requesting that the court
7	allow the appearance of the party or a witness by telephone or by other two-way electronic
8	communication device in a proceeding under ORS 107.700 to 107.735.
9	(2) In exercising its discretion to allow written notice less than 30 days before the pro-
10	ceeding as required under ORS 45.400 (2), the court shall consider the expedited nature of a
11	proceeding under ORS 107.700 to 107.735.
12	(3) In addition to the factors listed in ORS 45.400 (7) that would support a finding of good
13	cause, the court shall consider whether the safety or welfare of the party or witness would
14	be threatened if testimony were required to be provided in person at a proceeding under ORS
15	107.700 to 107.735.
16	(4) A motion or good cause determination under this section or ORS 45.400 is not re-
17	quired for ex parte hearings held by telephone under ORS 107.718.
