Requires State Department of Agriculture to adopt rules establishing standards of identity and quality and labeling requirements for honey sold in Oregon.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to honey. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 616. 4 SECTION 2. The State Department of Agriculture shall adopt rules under ORS 616.205 5 to 616.385 establishing standards of identity and quality and labeling requirements for honey 6 sold in this state. In establishing or amending standards and requirements under this sec-7 8 tion, in addition to the definitions and standards described under ORS 616.230 and 616.325, the 9 department shall give consideration to any definitions and standards used by a federal agency, another state or an organization administering a regional, multiregional, national 10 or international agreement on honey. 11 12
