

House Bill 2947

Sponsored by Representative CLEM (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Department of Agriculture to adopt rules establishing standards of identity and quality and labeling requirements for honey sold in Oregon.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to honey.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 616.**

5 **SECTION 2. The State Department of Agriculture shall adopt rules under ORS 616.205**
6 **to 616.385 establishing standards of identity and quality and labeling requirements for honey**
7 **sold in this state. In establishing or amending standards and requirements under this sec-**
8 **tion, in addition to the definitions and standards described under ORS 616.230 and 616.325, the**
9 **department shall give consideration to any definitions and standards used by a federal**
10 **agency, another state or an organization administering a regional, multiregional, national**
11 **or international agreement on honey.**
