## House Bill 2950

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows Director of the Department of Environmental Quality to enter into certain agreements related to releases of hazardous substances.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to releases of hazardous substances.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 465.200 to 5 465.545.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any provision of 465.200 to 465.545 and 465.900, whenever 6 practicable and in the public interest, as determined by the Director of the Department of 7 8 Environmental Quality, the director may, through an administrative agreement, provide a person with a covenant not to sue concerning any future liability to any person under the 9 provisions of ORS 465.200 to 465.545 and 465.900 if the director determines that the person 10 who is a party to the agreement has performed all necessary removal or remedial actions 11 12 related to the release of a hazardous substance from a facility. SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2011 Act applies to agreements entered into by the Director 13of the Department of Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act 14 for releases of hazardous substances from facilities occurring before, on or after the effec-15

16 tive date of this 2011 Act.

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
