House Bill 3006

Sponsored by Representative GILLIAM

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Creates Independent Multidisciplinary Dairy Animal Welfare Board. Establishes duties of board.

2	Relating to dairy animals.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. As used in this section and sections 2 and 3 of this 2011 Act:
5	(1) "Confined animal feeding operation" has the meaning given that term in ORS
6	468B.205.
7	(2) "Dairy animal" means an animal that is commercially raised for milk production
8	purposes and is housed in a confined animal feeding operation.
9	SECTION 2. (1) There is established an Independent Multidisciplinary Dairy Animal
10	Welfare Board. The State Veterinarian shall serve as chairperson of the board. In addition
11	to the State Veterinarian, the board shall have not more than five members appointed by the
12	Director of Agriculture.
13	(2) The appointed members of the board must be residents of this state who are well in-
14	formed on scientific or veterinary principles regarding dairy animal care, welfare and
15	husbandry and recognized agricultural practices affecting dairy animals.
16	(3) The term of office of each appointed member is two years, but an appointed member
17	serves at the pleasure of the director. Members are eligible for reappointment. The ap-
18	pointment of a member by the director shall be after consultation with, and is subject to
19	confirmation by, the State Board of Agriculture.
20	(4) A majority of the members of the Independent Multidisciplinary Dairy Animal Welfare
21	Board constitutes a quorum for the transaction of business.
22	(5) The board shall meet once each biennium for the purpose of submitting comments
23	under section 3 (1)(a) of this 2011 Act regarding legislation. The board may meet at other
24	times and places specified by the call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of
25	the board for the purpose of carrying out other board duties described in section 3 of this
26	2011 Act.
27	(6) The State Department of Agriculture shall provide administrative support to the
28	board.
29	(7) A member of the board is entitled to compensation and expenses as provided in ORS
30	292.495. Payment of compensation and expenses of the board shall be from funds available
31	to the department.

2 garding potential impacts on dairy animal care and welfare and on the safety of human dairy

3 food supplies, on:

4 (a) Legislation dealing with dairy animal care, welfare or husbandry or with agricultural
5 practices affecting dairy animals;

6 (b) Proposed or adopted administrative rules dealing with dairy animal care, welfare or 7 husbandry or with agricultural practices affecting dairy animals;

8 (c) Ballot measures certified to the ballot dealing with dairy animal care, welfare or 9 husbandry or with agricultural practices affecting dairy animals; and

(d) Decisions of the Supreme Court or the Court of Appeals that may have a significant
effect on laws or rules regarding dairy animal care, welfare or husbandry or on agricultural
practices affecting dairy animals.

13 (2) The board shall act as an independent scientific peer review panel for state agencies that are responsible for regulating dairy animal care and welfare or regulating confined an-14 15imal feeding operations that house dairy animals. If the board submits a suggestion to a 16state agency regarding the regulation of dairy animal care and welfare or the regulation of confined animal feeding operations that house dairy animals, the agency shall respond in 17 18 writing to the board regarding the suggestion. If the state agency intends to implement a suggestion submitted by the board, the agency response shall include, but need not be limited 19 to, a description of how the agency intends to accomplish implementation of the suggestion. 20If the state agency does not intend to implement a suggestion submitted by the board, the 2122agency response shall include, but need not be limited to, the reasons that the agency does 23not intend to implement the suggestion.

(3) The board shall provide advisory services as requested by legislative committees.
However, the board may not submit proposals for legislation.

(4) In carrying out duties under this section, the board shall operate under guidelines and
practices that are generally accepted by the scientific community as appropriate for use by
independent science boards.

29 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding the term of office specified by section 2 of this 2011 Act, 30 the Director of Agriculture may adjust the term of members first appointed to the Inde-31 pendent Multidisciplinary Dairy Animal Welfare Board to reduce the disruption of board 32 functions when member terms expire.

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
