House Bill 3022

Sponsored by Representative THOMPSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs State Board of Pharmacy to classify certain synthetic cannabinoid compounds as Schedule I controlled substances.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to controlled substances; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. The State Board of Pharmacy shall classify as a controlled substance in 4 Schedule I the following substances, including their isomers, homologues, esters, ethers, $\mathbf{5}$ salts and salts of isomers, esters and ethers, except when in the possession of a manufac-6 turer or research facility registered with the federal Food and Drug Administration, or of a 7

27SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 28 on its passage. 29
