House Bill 3032

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Allows county court or board of commissioners to examine financial affairs of county at regular business meeting twice during year at any time, rather than in January and July.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to county financial affairs; amending ORS 294.085.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - **SECTION 1.** ORS 294.085 is amended to read:
 - 294.085. (1) **Twice each year while sitting for county business,** the county court or board of county commissioners[, while sitting for county business at the regular terms in January and July of each year,] shall carefully examine all books and papers relating to the financial affairs of the county offices of county clerk, clerk of the county court, treasurer and sheriff of the county.
 - (2) The county clerk and clerk of the county court shall exhibit the numbered orders and vouchers referred to in ORS 294.090, together with the stubs of the warrants, and all other books and papers relating to the financial affairs of the county, for the inspection of the county court or board of county commissioners **twice each year during the examination of financial affairs required by** [at the time provided for in] subsection (1) of this section.
