

House Bill 3036

Sponsored by Representative THATCHER (at the request of Randy McKee)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires community college or state institution of higher education to expel any student convicted of riot.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to post-secondary institution response to student conviction for riot.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. A community college district shall expel a student if that student is con-**
5 **victed of the crime of riot under ORS 166.015.**

6 **SECTION 2. A state institution of higher education listed in ORS 352.002 shall expel a**
7 **student if that student is convicted of the crime of riot under ORS 166.015.**

8 **SECTION 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this 2011 Act apply to convictions for the crime of riot**
9 **occurring on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.**
