

House Bill 3093

Sponsored by Representative HICKS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Reduces amount of usable medical marijuana that person may possess to one ounce.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to medical marijuana; amending ORS 475.320.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 475.320 is amended to read:

5 475.320. (1)[(a)] A registry identification cardholder or the designated primary caregiver of the
6 cardholder may possess up to six mature marijuana plants and [24 ounces] **one ounce** of usable
7 marijuana.

8 *[(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, if a registry identification cardholder has*
9 *been convicted of a Class A or Class B felony under ORS 475.840 to 475.920 for the manufacture or*
10 *delivery of a controlled substance in Schedule I or Schedule II, the registry identification cardholder*
11 *or the designated primary caregiver of the cardholder may possess one ounce of usable marijuana at*
12 *any given time for a period of five years from the date of the conviction.]*

13 (2) A person authorized under ORS 475.304 to produce marijuana at a marijuana grow site:

14 (a) May produce marijuana for and provide marijuana to a registry identification cardholder or
15 that person's designated primary caregiver as authorized under this section.

16 (b) May possess up to six mature plants and up to [24 ounces] **one ounce** of usable marijuana
17 for each cardholder or caregiver for whom marijuana is being produced.

18 (c) May produce marijuana for no more than four registry identification cardholders or desig-
19 nated primary caregivers concurrently.

20 (d) Must obtain and display a marijuana grow site registration card issued under ORS 475.304
21 for each registry identification cardholder or designated primary caregiver for whom marijuana is
22 being produced.

23 (e) Must provide all marijuana produced for a registry identification cardholder or designated
24 primary caregiver to the cardholder or caregiver at the time the person responsible for a marijuana
25 grow site ceases producing marijuana for the cardholder or caregiver.

26 (f) Must return the marijuana grow site registration card to the registry identification
27 cardholder to whom the card was issued when requested to do so by the cardholder or when the
28 person responsible for a marijuana grow site ceases producing marijuana for the cardholder or
29 caregiver.

30 (3) [*Except as provided in subsections (1) and (2) of this section,*] A registry identification
31 cardholder, the designated primary caregiver of the cardholder and the person responsible for a
32 marijuana grow site producing marijuana for the registry identification cardholder may possess a

1 combined total of up to six mature plants and [24 ounces] **one ounce** of usable marijuana for that
2 registry identification cardholder.

3 (4)(a) A registry identification cardholder and the designated primary caregiver of the
4 cardholder may possess a combined total of up to 18 marijuana seedlings or starts as defined by rule
5 of the Oregon Health Authority.

6 (b) A person responsible for a marijuana grow site may possess up to 18 marijuana seedlings or
7 starts as defined by rule of the authority for each registry identification cardholder for whom the
8 person responsible for the marijuana grow site is producing marijuana.
