Authorizes local jurisdiction to use official website to make public information about sex offender present in local jurisdiction.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the release of sex offender information.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding ORS 181.592, a local jurisdiction may use the official website

5 of the local jurisdiction to make available to the public any identifying information about a

6 person required to report as a sex offender under ORS 181.595, 181.596 or 181.597 who resides,

7 attends an institution of higher education, works or carries on a vocation or is otherwise
