

# House Bill 3121

Sponsored by Representative KENNEMER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Eliminates requirement that person operating manually propelled boat obtain aquatic invasive species prevention permit.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to aquatic invasive species; creating new provisions; amending ORS 830.565, 830.570 and  
3 830.575; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 830.565 is amended to read:

6 830.565. [(1)] A person may not operate a [*manually propelled boat that is 10 feet or more in*  
7 *length or a*] motorboat on the waters of this state without first obtaining an aquatic invasive species  
8 prevention permit from the State Marine Board under ORS 830.570.

9 [(2) *A person who obtains an aquatic invasive species prevention permit for a manually propelled*  
10 *boat may use the permit on any manually propelled boat the person operates on the waters of this*  
11 *state.*]

12 **SECTION 2.** ORS 830.570 is amended to read:

13 830.570. (1) The State Marine Board shall issue and renew an aquatic invasive species pre-  
14 vention permit to a person who pays the fee for the permit described in ORS 830.575.

15 (2) The board may appoint agents to issue aquatic invasive species prevention permits.

16 (3) Agents shall issue permits in accordance with procedures prescribed by the board by rule  
17 and shall charge and collect the aquatic invasive species prevention permit fees prescribed by law.

18 (4) The board may authorize an agent other than a board employee to charge a service fee of  
19 \$2, in addition to the permit fee, for the issuance service performed by the agent.

20 (5) The board shall supply the agents with [*motorboat and manually propelled boat*] aquatic  
21 invasive species prevention permits.

22 **SECTION 3.** ORS 830.575 is amended to read:

23 830.575. Notwithstanding ORS 830.790 (3), fees for issuance and renewal of an aquatic invasive  
24 species prevention permit are as follows:

25 (1) The biennial fee for a motorboat issued a certificate of number under ORS 830.795 is \$5.

26 [(2) *The annual fee for a manually propelled boat 10 feet or more in length is \$5.*]

27 [(3)] (2) The annual fee for a motorboat operated by a nonresident is \$20.

28 [(4) *The annual fee for an operator of a boat livery is:*]

29 [(a) *\$30 for an operator who owns 6 to 10 manually propelled boats;*]

30 [(b) *\$55 for an operator who owns 11 to 20 manually propelled boats; or*]

31 [(c) *\$100 for an operator who owns 21 or more manually propelled boats.*]

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted.  
New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1        **SECTION 4.** The amendments to ORS 830.565 and 830.570 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2011  
2 Act apply to manually propelled boats operated on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.

3        **SECTION 5.** This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
4 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect  
5 on its passage.  
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
