SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates crime of unlawful delivery of Salvia divinorum. Punishes by maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Salvia divinorum.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) A person commits the crime of unlawful delivery of Salvia divinorum if

5 the person knowingly sells, gives or otherwise makes Salvia divinorum available to a person

6 who is under 21 years of age.

7 (2) Unlawful delivery of Salvia divinorum is a Class A misdemeanor.
