House Bill 3143

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits health care provider from billing for medical equipment that is not covered by patient's insurance under specified circumstances.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to the cost of medical equipment.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. A health care provider may not bill a patient for an item of medical equip-
5	ment that is not covered by the patient's insurance, and the patient is not liable for the cost
6	of an item of medical equipment that is not covered by the patient's insurance, if at the time
7	the item is offered the patient presents evidence of valid insurance coverage and:
8	(1) The provider fails to contact the insurer to find out if the item is covered; or
9	(2) The provider fails to verbally inform the patient that the item is not covered or is
10	unlikely to be covered by the patient's insurance.
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
