Adjusts sunset for tax credit for electronic commerce in enterprise zone or city designated for electronic commerce.

6	Sec. 3. Except as provided in ORS 315.507 (5), a credit may not be claimed under ORS 315.507
7	for tax years beginning on or after January 1, [2012]
8	SECTION 2. This 2011 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2011
9	session of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
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
