(b) If a parent or other person in parental relationship to a child cannot be contacted 14 15in person or directly by telephone and another method has not been identified by the parent 16 or person, a message shall be left for the parent or person, if possible. 17 "(4) Notice of the child's absence shall be provided to the attendance supervisor, who 18 shall proceed as provided in ORS 339.055, if: 19 "(a) Notification is not provided in person or directly by telephone; and 20 (b) The parent or other person in parental relationship to the child has not confirmed 21within the timeline established by the attendance notification policy that the parent or person has received notification.". 2223
