

House Bill 3209

Sponsored by Representative WHISNANT; Representatives BARKER, BOONE, ESQUIVEL, HUFFMAN, MATTHEWS, WITT, Senator DEVLIN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits former prisoners of war, recipients of Congressional Medal of Honor, persons awarded Purple Heart medal and gold star family members to register vehicle by paying one-time vehicle registration fee.

2 Relating to vehicles; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 801.041, 801.042, 803.350, 803.400,
3 803.415, 803.420, 805.103, 805.105 and 805.110.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. Sections 2 to 4 of this 2011 Act are added to and made a part of the Oregon**
6 **Vehicle Code.**

7 **SECTION 2. (1) In the absence of just cause for refusal, the Department of Transporta-**
8 **tion shall provide for registration of any vehicle required to be registered by this state in a**
9 **manner consistent with this section for persons who qualify as gold star family members**
10 **under subsection (2) of this section. The special registration provisions under this section**
11 **are subject to all of the following:**

12 (a) **The fee is the one-time registration fee established by ORS 803.420 for vehicles reg-**
13 **istered under this section.**

14 (b) **The department may issue registrations for vehicles in a household under this section**
15 **in a number equal to the number of persons in the household who qualify as gold star family**
16 **members under subsection (2) of this section.**

17 (c) **The department may not register under this section any commercial vehicle or any**
18 **motor vehicle with a loaded weight in excess of 10,000 pounds.**

19 (2)(a) **A person is a gold star family member who qualifies for registration of a vehicle**
20 **under this section if the person is a parent, spouse or dependent of a person who was killed**
21 **in action during an armed conflict while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.**

22 (b) **The department shall determine by rule what constitutes proof that a person is a**
23 **parent, spouse or dependent of a person who was killed in action during an armed conflict**
24 **while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.**

25 (3) **Registration issued under this section is valid as provided in ORS 803.415. The regis-**
26 **tration period for vehicles registered under this section exempts the registration from any**
27 **requirement to be renewed or to make payment of renewal fees. However, if any owner**
28 **would be required to comply with ORS 815.310 upon issuance or renewal of regular registra-**
29 **tion for the vehicle, the owner must comply with ORS 815.310 in the same manner as for**
30 **other vehicles or the department may suspend the registration of the vehicle until the owner**

2 (4) The department may suspend or revoke any registration issued under this section if
 3 the department determines that the vehicle is owned by a person not qualified for registra-
 4 tion under this section or the vehicle is a kind not qualified for registration under this sec-
 5 tion.

6 **SECTION 3.** (1) In the absence of just cause for refusal, the Department of Transporta-
 7 tion shall provide for registration of any vehicle required to be registered by this state in a
 8 manner consistent with this section for persons who were awarded the Purple Heart medal
 9 by the Armed Forces of the United States. The special registration provisions under this
 10 section are subject to all of the following:

11 (a) The fee is the one-time registration fee established by ORS 803.420 for vehicles reg-
 12 istered under this section.

13 (b) The department may issue registrations for vehicles in a household under this section
 14 in a number equal to the number of persons in the household who have been awarded the
 15 Purple Heart medal by the Armed Forces of the United States.

16 (c) The department may not register under this section any commercial vehicle or any
 17 motor vehicle with a loaded weight in excess of 10,000 pounds.

18 (2) A person applying for registration under this section shall prove to the satisfaction
 19 of the department that the person has been awarded the Purple Heart medal by the Armed
 20 Forces of the United States.

21 (3) The surviving spouse of a Purple Heart medal recipient who was issued registration
 22 under this section may, upon the death of the Purple Heart medal recipient, continue to use
 23 the registration plates on a motor vehicle or keep the plates as a memento.

24 (4) Registration issued under this section is valid as provided in ORS 803.415. The regis-
 25 tration period for vehicles registered under this section exempts the registration from any
 26 requirement to be renewed or to make payment of renewal fees. However, if any owner
 27 would be required to comply with ORS 815.310 upon issuance or renewal of regular registra-
 28 tion for the vehicle, the owner must comply with ORS 815.310 in the same manner as for
 29 other vehicles or the department may suspend the registration of the vehicle until the owner
 30 submits proof of compliance.

31 (5) The department may suspend or revoke any registration issued under this section if
 32 the department determines that the vehicle is owned by a person not qualified for registra-
 33 tion under this section or the vehicle is a kind not qualified for registration under this sec-
 34 tion.

35 **SECTION 4.** (1) In the absence of just cause for refusal, the Department of Transporta-
 36 tion shall provide for registration of any vehicle required to be registered by this state in a
 37 manner consistent with this section for recipients of the Congressional Medal of Honor. The
 38 special registration provisions under this section are subject to all of the following:

39 (a) The fee is the one-time registration fee established by ORS 803.420 for vehicles reg-
 40 istered under this section.

41 (b) The department may issue registrations for vehicles in a household under this section
 42 in a number equal to the number of persons in the household who are recipients of the
 43 Congressional Medal of Honor.

44 (c) The department may not register under this section any commercial vehicle or any
 45 motor vehicle with a loaded weight in excess of 10,000 pounds.

1 **(2) A person applying for registration under this section shall prove to the satisfaction**
 2 **of the department that the person is a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor.**

3 **(3) The surviving spouse of a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient who was issued a**
 4 **registration under this section may, upon the death of the Congressional Medal of Honor**
 5 **recipient, keep the plates as a memento.**

6 **(4) Registration issued under this section is valid as provided in ORS 803.415. The regis-**
 7 **tration period for vehicles registered under this section exempts the registration from any**
 8 **requirement to be renewed or to make payment of renewal fees. However, if any owner**
 9 **would be required to comply with ORS 815.310 upon issuance or renewal of regular registra-**
 10 **tion for the vehicle, the owner must comply with ORS 815.310 in the same manner as for**
 11 **other vehicles or the department may suspend the registration of the vehicle until the owner**
 12 **submits proof of compliance.**

13 **(5) The department may suspend or revoke any registration issued under this section if**
 14 **the department determines that the vehicle is owned by a person not qualified for registra-**
 15 **tion under this section or the vehicle is a kind not qualified for registration under this sec-**
 16 **tion.**

17 **SECTION 5.** ORS 805.103, as amended by section 4, chapter 61, Oregon Laws 2010, is amended
 18 to read:

19 805.103. (1) The Department of Transportation shall provide for issuance of registration plates
 20 for a motor vehicle registered under [*ORS 803.420 (1) or (9)(a)*] **section 4 of this 2011 Act**, in a
 21 manner consistent with this section, to motor vehicle owners who qualify for the plates as Con-
 22 gressional Medal of Honor recipients under subsection (2) this section.

23 (2) A person who is a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient qualifies for registration plates
 24 under this section if the person provides the department with a certificate from the United States
 25 Department of Veterans Affairs attesting to the person's status as a Congressional Medal of Honor
 26 recipient.

27 (3) Registration plates issued under this section shall be considered customized registration
 28 plates for purposes of the fee required in ORS 805.250. The department may waive the fee required
 29 in ORS 805.250.

30 (4) The department may not issue registration plates for a motor vehicle under this section if
 31 another motor vehicle owned by the applicant has been issued registration plates under this section.

32 (5) The registration plates issued under this section shall:

- 33 (a) Be issued with a unique background design determined by the department;
- 34 (b) Be issued with a specific configuration as determined by the department;
- 35 (c) Contain the words "Medal of Honor";
- 36 (d) Contain the image of the Congressional Medal of Honor; and
- 37 (e) Meet the requirements for registration plates under ORS 803.535.

38 (6) If there is a transfer of interest in the motor vehicle to which the registration plate under
 39 this section is assigned, or if the motor vehicle is totaled and not reconstructed, the motor vehicle
 40 owner shall remove the registration plate. The Congressional Medal of Honor recipient may retain
 41 the registration plate, but the registration plate may not be placed on any other motor vehicle un-
 42 less the registration plate is transferred as set forth in subsection (7) of this section.

43 (7) If the motor vehicle owner qualifies for the registration plates under subsection (2) of this
 44 section, the department may transfer registration plates issued under this section to another motor
 45 vehicle registered under [*ORS 803.420 (1) or (9)(a)*] **section 4 of this 2011 Act**, as set forth in ORS

2 (8) The department shall cancel any registration plates issued under this section if the depart-
 3 ment determines that the motor vehicle is owned by a person who does not qualify for the regis-
 4 tration plates under subsection (2) of this section or that the motor vehicle is not registered under
 5 [ORS 803.420 (1) or (9)(a)] **section 4 of this 2011 Act.**

6 (9) The department may adopt rules necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.

7 **SECTION 6.** ORS 805.105 is amended to read:

8 805.105. (1) The Department of Transportation shall establish a veterans' recognition registra-
 9 tion plate program to issue registration plates called "veterans' recognition registration plates"
 10 upon request to an owner of any motor vehicle registered under ORS 803.420 (1) or (9)(a) **or 805.110**
 11 **or sections 2 to 4 of this 2011 Act** if the owner of the motor vehicle qualifies for the plates. Rules
 12 adopted under this section shall include, but need not be limited to, rules that:

13 (a) Describe general qualifications to be met by any veterans' group in order to be eligible for
 14 a veterans' recognition registration plate issued under this section.

15 (b) Specify circumstances under which the department may cease to issue veterans' recognition
 16 registration plates.

17 (c) Specify what constitutes proof of veteran status for issuance of a veterans' recognition reg-
 18 istration plate, if such proof is required by a veterans' group or by the Director of Veterans' Affairs.

19 (d) Specify what constitutes proof that a person is a surviving family member of a person who
 20 was killed in action during an armed conflict while serving in the Armed Forces of the United
 21 States. The department may only issue a veteran's recognition registration plate displaying a gold
 22 star decal and the words "Gold Star Family" to a person who is a parent, spouse or dependent of
 23 a person who was killed in action during an armed conflict while serving in the Armed Forces of
 24 the United States.

25 (2)(a) In addition to any other fee authorized by law, upon issuance of a veterans' recognition
 26 registration plate under this section and upon renewal of registration for a vehicle that has plates
 27 issued under this section, the department shall collect a surcharge of \$2.50 per plate for each year
 28 of the registration period for the vehicle as described under ORS 803.415.

29 (b) Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (c) of this subsection, net proceeds of the sur-
 30 charge collected by the department for the veterans' recognition registration plate shall be deposited
 31 in the trust fund established under ORS 406.050 for paying the expenses of operating the Oregon
 32 Veterans' Home.

33 (c) If the department issues a veterans' recognition registration plate that names, describes or
 34 represents a veterans' group, that veterans' group may designate an account into which the net
 35 proceeds of the surcharge collected by the department under this section are to be deposited. The
 36 department shall keep accurate records of the number of plates issued under this paragraph for each
 37 veterans' group and, after payment of administrative expenses of the department, shall deposit
 38 moneys collected under this subsection into the specified account.

39 (d) Deposits under this subsection shall be made quarterly.

40 (3)(a) In consultation with the Department of Transportation, the Director of Veterans' Affairs
 41 shall design the veterans' recognition registration plate.

42 (b) If the department issues a veterans' recognition registration plate to recognize a veterans'
 43 group, the department shall, in consultation with the requesting veterans' group, add words or a
 44 military-related decal to the veterans' recognition registration plate that names, describes or re-
 45 presents the veterans' group.

1 (c) The department shall add a gold star decal and the words “Gold Star Family” to a veterans’
2 recognition registration plate background to recognize surviving family members of persons killed
3 in action during an armed conflict while serving in the Armed Forces of the United States.

4 (d) Except as otherwise required by the design, veterans’ recognition registration plates must
5 comply with the requirements of ORS 803.535.

6 (4) The department shall determine how many sets of veterans’ recognition registration plates
7 will be manufactured. If the department does not sell or issue renewal for 500 sets of veterans’ re-
8 cognition registration plates in any one year, the department shall cease production of veterans’
9 recognition registration plates. For the purposes of this section, veterans’ recognition registration
10 plates that name, describe or represent a veterans’ group are included in the total number of
11 veterans’ recognition registration plates issued.

12 **SECTION 7.** ORS 805.110 is amended to read:

13 805.110. (1) In the absence of just cause for refusal, the Department of Transportation shall
14 provide for registration of any motor vehicle required to be registered by this state in a manner
15 consistent with this section for persons who qualify as former prisoners of war under **subsection**
16 **(2)** of this section. The special registration provisions under this section are subject to all of the
17 following:

18 *[(a) The fee to register or renew registration under this section shall be the regular registration fee*
19 *for the vehicle.]*

20 **(a) The fee is the one-time registration fee established by ORS 803.420 for vehicles reg-**
21 **istered under this section.**

22 (b) The department *[shall]* **may** not register a motor vehicle under this section if another vehicle
23 owned by the applicant or a member of the applicant’s household has been registered under this
24 section.

25 (c) The department *[shall]* **may** not register **under this section** any commercial vehicle *[under*
26 *this section]* or any motor vehicle with a loaded weight in excess of 10,000 pounds.

27 (2) A person is a former prisoner of war who qualifies for registration of a vehicle under this
28 section if the person, while serving in the active military, naval or air service of the United States
29 or any of its Allies, was forcibly detained or interned in **the** line of duty:

30 (a) By an enemy government or its agents, or a hostile force, during a period of war; or

31 (b) By a foreign government or its agents, or a hostile force during a period other than a period
32 of war in which such person was held under circumstances which the department finds to have been
33 comparable to the circumstances under which persons have generally been forcibly detained or
34 interned by enemy governments during periods of war.

35 (3) The surviving spouse of a former prisoner of war who was issued registration under this
36 section may, upon the death of the former prisoner of war, continue to use the registration plates
37 on a motor vehicle or *[may]* keep the plates as a memento.

38 **(4) Registration issued under this section is valid as provided in ORS 803.415. The regis-**
39 **tration period for vehicles registered under this section exempts the registration from any**
40 **requirement to be renewed or to make payment of renewal fees. However, if any owner**
41 **would be required to comply with ORS 815.310 upon issuance or renewal of regular registra-**
42 **tion for the vehicle, the owner must comply with ORS 815.310 in the same manner as for**
43 **other vehicles or the department may suspend the registration of the vehicle until the owner**
44 **submits proof of compliance.**

45 *[(4)]* **(5)** The department may suspend or revoke any registration issued under this section if the

1 department determines that the vehicle is owned by a person not qualified for registration under this
 2 section or the vehicle is a kind not qualified for registration under this section.

3 **SECTION 8.** ORS 801.041 is amended to read:

4 801.041. The following apply to the authority granted to counties by ORS 801.040 to establish
 5 registration fees for vehicles:

6 (1) An ordinance establishing registration fees under this section must be enacted by the county
 7 imposing the registration fee and filed with the Department of Transportation. Notwithstanding
 8 ORS 203.055 or any provision of a county charter, the governing body of a county with a population
 9 of 350,000 or more may enact an ordinance establishing registration fees for the purpose of design-
 10 ing, replacing, acquiring necessary property for, engineering and constructing a bridge and its ap-
 11 proach that crosses the Willamette River in the City of Portland. Except for motor vehicles
 12 registered as government-owned vehicles under ORS 805.040, the bridge shall be restricted to motor
 13 vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,000 pounds or less. The governing body of the
 14 county imposing the registration fee shall enter into an intergovernmental agreement under ORS
 15 190.010 with the department by which the department shall collect the registration fees, pay them
 16 over to the county and, if necessary, allow the credit or credits described in ORS 803.445 (5). The
 17 intergovernmental agreement must state the date on which the department shall begin collecting
 18 registration fees for the county.

19 (2) The authority granted by this section allows the establishment of registration fees in addition
 20 to those described in ORS 803.420. There is no authority under this section to affect registration
 21 periods, qualifications, cards, plates, requirements or any other provision relating to vehicle regis-
 22 tration under the vehicle code.

23 (3) Except as otherwise provided for in this subsection, when registration fees are imposed under
 24 this section, they must be imposed on all vehicle classes. Registration fees as provided under this
 25 section may not be imposed on the following:

- 26 (a) Snowmobiles and Class I all-terrain vehicles.

45 (4) Any registration fee imposed by a county must be a fixed amount not to exceed, with respect

1 to any vehicle class, the registration fee established under ORS 803.420 (1). For vehicles on which
 2 a flat fee is imposed under ORS 803.420, the fee must be a whole dollar amount.

3 (5) Moneys from registration fees established under this section must be paid to the county es-
 4 tablishing the registration fees as provided in ORS 802.110. The moneys shall be used for the nec-
 5 cessary property acquisition for and the design, replacement, engineering and construction of a
 6 bridge and its approach that crosses the Willamette River in the City of Portland. Except for motor
 7 vehicles registered as government-owned vehicles under ORS 805.040, the bridge shall be restricted
 8 to motor vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of 26,000 pounds or less.

9 (6) Two or more counties may act jointly to impose a registration fee under this section. The
 10 ordinance of each county acting jointly with another under this subsection must provide for the
 11 distribution of moneys collected through a joint registration fee.

12 **SECTION 9.** ORS 801.041, as amended by section 40a, chapter 865, Oregon Laws 2009, is
 13 amended to read:

14 801.041. The following apply to the authority granted to counties by ORS 801.040 to establish
 15 registration fees for vehicles:

16 (1) An ordinance establishing registration fees under this section must be enacted by the county
 17 imposing the registration fee and filed with the Department of Transportation. Notwithstanding
 18 ORS 203.055 or any provision of a county charter, the governing body of a county with a population
 19 of 350,000 or more may enact an ordinance establishing registration fees. The governing body of a
 20 county with a population of less than 350,000 may enact an ordinance establishing registration fees
 21 after submitting the ordinance to the electors of the county for their approval. The governing body
 22 of the county imposing the registration fee shall enter into an intergovernmental agreement under
 23 ORS 190.010 with the department by which the department shall collect the registration fees, pay
 24 them over to the county and, if necessary, allow the credit or credits described in ORS 803.445 (5).
 25 The intergovernmental agreement must state the date on which the department shall begin collect-
 26 ing registration fees for the county.

27 (2) The authority granted by this section allows the establishment of registration fees in addition

8 (4) Any registration fee imposed by a county must be a fixed amount not to exceed, with respect
 9 to any vehicle class, the registration fee established under ORS 803.420 (1). For vehicles on which
 10 a flat fee is imposed under ORS 803.420, the fee must be a whole dollar amount.

11 (5) Moneys from registration fees established under this section must be paid to the county es-
 12 tablishing the registration fees as provided in ORS 802.110. The county ordinance shall provide for
 13 payment of at least 40 percent of the moneys to cities within the county unless a different distrib-
 14 ution is agreed upon by the county and the cities within the jurisdiction of the county. The moneys
 15 shall be used for any purpose for which moneys from registration fees may be used.

16 (6) Two or more counties may act jointly to impose a registration fee under this section. The
 17 ordinance of each county acting jointly with another under this subsection must provide for the
 18 distribution of moneys collected through a joint registration fee.

19 **SECTION 10.** ORS 801.042 is amended to read:

20 801.042. The following apply to the authority granted to a district by ORS 801.040 to establish
 21 registration fees for vehicles:

22 (1) Before the governing body of a district can impose a registration fee under this section, it
 23 must submit the proposal to the electors of the district for their approval and, if the proposal is
 24 approved, enter into an intergovernmental agreement under ORS 190.010 with the governing bodies
 25 of all counties, other districts and cities with populations of over 300,000 that overlap the district.
 26 The intergovernmental agreement must state the registration fees and, if necessary, how the revenue
 27 from the fees shall be apportioned among counties and the districts. Before the governing body of
 28 a county can enter into such an intergovernmental agreement, the county shall consult with the
 29 cities in its jurisdiction.

30 (2) If a district raises revenues from a registration fee for purposes related to highways, roads,
 31 streets and roadside rest areas, the governing body of that district shall establish a Regional Ar-
 32 terial Fund and shall deposit in the Regional Arterial Fund all such registration fees.

33 (3) Interest received on moneys credited to the Regional Arterial Fund shall accrue to and be-
 34 come a part of the Regional Arterial Fund.

35 (4) The Regional Arterial Fund must be administered by the governing body of the district re-
 36 ferred to in subsection (2) of this section and such governing body by ordinance may disburse mon-
 37 eys in the Regional Arterial Fund. Moneys within the Regional Arterial Fund may be disbursed only
 38 for a program of projects recommended by a joint policy advisory committee on transportation
 39 consisting of local officials and state agency representatives designated by the district referred to
 40 in subsection (2) of this section. The projects for which the joint policy advisory committee on
 41 transportation can recommend funding must concern arterials, collectors or other improvements
 42 designated by the joint policy advisory committee on transportation.

43 (5) Ordinances establishing registration fees under this section must be filed with the Depart-
 44 ment of Transportation. The governing body of the district imposing the registration fee shall enter
 45 into an intergovernmental agreement under ORS 190.010 with the department by which the depart-

1 ment shall collect the registration fees, pay them over to the district and, if necessary, allow the
 2 credit or credits described in ORS 803.445 (5). The intergovernmental agreement must state the date
 3 on which the department shall begin collecting registration fees for the district.

4 (6) The authority granted by this section allows the establishment of registration fees in addition
 5 to those described in ORS 803.420. There is no authority under this section to affect registration
 6 periods, qualifications, cards, plates, requirements or any other provision relating to vehicle regis-
 7 tration under the vehicle code.

8 (7) Except as otherwise provided for in this subsection, when registration fees are imposed under
 9 this section, the fees must be imposed on all vehicle classes. Registration fees as provided under this
 10 section may not be imposed on the following:

- 11 (a) Snowmobiles and Class I all-terrain vehicles.
- 12 (b) Fixed load vehicles.
- 13 (c) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.100 to disabled veterans.
- 14 (d) Vehicles registered as antique vehicles under ORS 805.010.
- 15 (e) Vehicles registered as vehicles of special interest under ORS 805.020.
- 16 (f) Government-owned or operated vehicles registered under ORS 805.040 or 805.045.
- 17 (g) School buses or school activity vehicles registered under ORS 805.050.
- 18 (h) Law enforcement undercover vehicles registered under ORS 805.060.
- 19 (i) Vehicles registered on a proportional basis for interstate operation.
- 20 (j) Vehicles with a registration weight of 26,001 pounds or more described in ORS 803.420 (10)
- 21 or (11).
- 22 (k) Vehicles registered as farm vehicles under the provisions of ORS 805.300.
- 23 (L) Travel trailers, campers and motor homes.
- 24 **(m) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.110 to former prisoners of war.**
- 25 **(n) Vehicles registered under section 2 of this 2011 Act to gold star family members.**
- 26 **(o) Vehicles registered under section 3 of this 2011 Act to recipients of the Purple Heart**
- 27 **medal.**
- 28 **(p) Vehicles registered under section 4 of this 2011 Act to recipients of the Congressional**
- 29 **Medal of Honor.**

30 (8) Any registration fee imposed by the governing body of a district must be a fixed amount not
 31 to exceed, with respect to any vehicle class, the registration fee established under ORS 803.420 (1).
 32 For vehicles on which a flat fee is imposed under ORS 803.420, the fee must be a whole dollar
 33 amount.

34 **SECTION 11.** ORS 803.350 is amended to read:

35 803.350. This section establishes the requirements for qualification for registration. The De-
 36 partment of Transportation [*shall*] **may** not issue registration to a vehicle if the requirements under
 37 this section are not met. The department, in the absence of just cause for refusing to register a
 38 vehicle upon application, shall assign a distinctive number or other distinctive means of identifica-
 39 tion and shall issue registration for a vehicle if all of the following requirements are met:

40 (1) The applicant applies for and is granted title in the applicant's name at the same time the
 41 person makes application for registration, or presents satisfactory evidence that title covering the
 42 vehicle has been previously issued to the applicant.

43 (2) The applicant completes an application described under ORS 803.370. If the vehicle is a re-
 44 constructed or assembled vehicle or a replica, the person must indicate that fact in the application
 45 or be subject to ORS 803.225.

1 (3) The applicant pays the department the registration fee established under ORS 803.420 and
 2 any applicable fees for issuance of registration plates.

3 (4) For motor vehicles, proof of compliance with pollution control equipment requirements is
 4 provided to the department. Proof required to comply with this subsection is described under ORS
 5 815.310. This subsection does not apply if the vehicle is exempt from the requirements for proof of
 6 compliance under ORS 815.300.

7 (5) The applicant is domiciled in this state, as described in ORS 803.355, if required by ORS
 8 803.360 to be domiciled in the state in order to register a vehicle. If the department has reason to
 9 believe that the applicant is not domiciled in this state and is required to be in order to register a
 10 vehicle, the department may require the person to submit proof of domicile. The department shall
 11 determine by rule what constitutes proof of domicile.

12 (6) The applicant owns a vehicle that qualifies under ORS 803.360 (2) for registration in this
 13 state, if the owner is not domiciled in this state and is not required by ORS 803.200, or any other
 14 provision of law, to register the vehicle in this state.

15 (7) The applicant surrenders all evidence of any former registration or title as required by ORS
 16 803.380.

17 (8)(a) Beginning with 2009 model year new motor vehicles, the applicant provides proof of com-
 18 pliance with low emission motor vehicle standards adopted pursuant to ORS 468A.360. The depart-
 19 ment shall determine by rule what constitutes proof of compliance with low emission motor vehicle
 20 standards.

21 (b) The department shall determine by rule which new motor vehicles are exempt from the re-
 22 quirements of this subsection. Any rules adopted pursuant to this paragraph shall be consistent with
 23 the Environmental Quality Commission standards adopted pursuant to ORS 468A.360.

24 (c) For purposes of this subsection, “new motor vehicle” means a motor vehicle with 7,500 miles
 25 or less on the odometer when the vehicle is initially registered under ORS 803.420 (1), 805.100,
 26 **805.110 or 805.120 or sections 2 to 4 of this 2011 Act.**

27 (9) If required to do so by the department, the applicant provides the department with satisfac-
 28 tory proof that the vehicle was designed to be operated on highways and meets equipment require-
 29 ments imposed by statute or rule for the lawful operation of a vehicle on highways. The department
 30 may adopt rules specifying the kinds of vehicles that are subject to this subsection and what con-
 31 stitutes satisfactory proof under this subsection.

32 **SECTION 12.** ORS 803.415 is amended to read:

33 803.415. This section establishes registration periods for vehicles. The registration periods are
 34 periods described under ORS 803.400. Except as provided in the following, the registration period for
 35 any vehicle registered in this state by the Department of Transportation is a biennial registration
 36 period:

37 (1) The following vehicles have permanent registration:

38 (a) Antique vehicles registered under ORS 805.010.

39 (b) Vehicles of special interest registered under ORS 805.020.

 3 (c) Vehicles registered as farm vehicles under ORS 805.300.
 4 (4) Snowmobiles are registered as provided in ORS 821.080.
 5 (5) Vehicles operated by dealers who hold certificates under ORS 822.020 are as provided under
 6 ORS 822.040.
 7 (6) Trailers for hire that will be operated at a loaded weight of 8,000 pounds or less may be
 8 registered as follows:
 9 (a) Annual registration; or
 10 (b) If registered under an agreement pursuant to ORS 802.500, for a period of time determined
 11 as specified in the agreement or as determined by the department.
 12 (7) Except as otherwise provided in subsection [(10)] (14) of this section, the registration period
 13 for electric vehicles and hybrid vehicles that use electricity and another source of motive power is
 14 a biennial registration period except that the registration period for the following electric or hybrid
 15 vehicles is an annual registration period:
 16 (a) Commercial buses.
 17 (b) Electric or hybrid vehicles registered as farm vehicles under ORS 805.300.
 18 (c) Vehicles required to establish registration weight under ORS 803.430.
 19 (8) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.100 have [an] ownership registration [period].
 20 (9) School vehicles registered under ORS 805.050 have ownership registration except that the
 21 registration shall continue to be valid if ownership of the vehicle is transferred to a person who
 22 continues to use the vehicle for purposes authorized by ORS 805.050.
 23 **(10) Vehicles registered under ORS 805.110 have ownership registration.**
 24 **(11) Vehicles registered under section 2 of this 2011 Act have ownership registration.**
 25 **(12) Vehicles registered under section 3 of this 2011 Act have ownership registration.**
 26 **(13) Vehicles registered under section 4 of this 2011 Act have ownership registration.**
 27 [(10)] (14) The following vehicles have a four-year registration period:
 28 (a) New vehicles registered under ORS 803.420 (1) for which new registration plates will be is-
 29 sued;
 30 (b) New mopeds registered under ORS 803.420 (2) for which new registration plates will be is-
 31 sued;
 32 (c) New motorcycles registered under ORS 803.420 (3) for which new registration plates will be
 33 issued; and
 34 (d) New vehicles registered under ORS 803.420 (9)(a) for which new registration plates will be
 35 issued.
 36 [(11)] (15) A rental or leasing company, as defined in ORS 221.275, may elect an annual, a
 37 biennial or a four-year registration period for the initial registration of a new vehicle registered
 38 under ORS 803.420 (1) or (9)(a) for which new registration plates will be issued if the company owns
 39 the vehicle that is being registered. The subsequent renewal or reregistration periods for the vehicle
 40 are biennial.
 41 **SECTION 13.** ORS 803.420 is amended to read:
 42 803.420. This section establishes registration fees for vehicles. If there is uncertainty as to the
 43 classification of a vehicle for purposes of the payment of registration fees under the vehicle code,
 44 the Department of Transportation may classify the vehicle to assure that registration fees for the
 45 vehicle are the same as for vehicles the department determines to be comparable. The registration

1 fees for the vehicle shall be those based on the classification determined by the department. Except

 28 parable nonelectric vehicles described in this section plus 50 percent of such fee:

29 (A) Motor homes.

30 (B) Commercial buses.

31 (C) Vehicles registered as farm vehicles under ORS 805.300.

32 (D) Vehicles required to establish registration weight under ORS 803.430 or 826.013.

33 (10) Motor vehicles required to establish a registration weight under ORS 803.430 or 826.013,
 34 and commercial buses as provided in the following chart, based upon the weight submitted in the
 35 declaration of weight prepared under ORS 803.435 or 826.015:

(c) The owner of a vehicle described in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection must certify at the time of initial registration, in a manner determined by the department by rule, that the motor vehicle will be used exclusively to transport manufactured structures or exclusively as described in ORS 822.210, 825.015 or 825.017 (14). Registration of a vehicle described in paragraphs (a) and (b) of this subsection is invalid if the vehicle is operated in any manner other than that described in the certification under this paragraph.

(12) Trailers registered under permanent registration, \$10.

(13) Fixed load vehicles as follows:

(a) If a declaration of weight described under ORS 803.435 is submitted establishing the weight of the vehicle at 3,000 pounds or less, \$54.

SECTION 14. ORS 803.400 is amended to read:

803.400. This section establishes and distinguishes registration periods. Each registration period determines the period of validity for vehicle registration. Registration under the following registration periods is valid during the described registration period:

(1)(a) Annual registration is valid for a one-year period. Except as provided in this subsection, the period starts on the first day of a calendar month and runs through the last day of the same calendar month one year later. Once a vehicle is registered under annual registration, the registration period of the vehicle begins and ends with that same calendar month each time the vehicle is reregistered or registration for the vehicle is renewed.

(b) Annual registration issued under ORS 803.415 [(11)] (15) starts on the day a vehicle is registered and runs through the same day one year later. Once a vehicle is registered annually under ORS 803.415 [(11)] (15), the registration period of the vehicle begins and ends with that same day each time the vehicle is reregistered or registration for the vehicle is renewed. Vehicles initially registered on February 29 will expire on the last day of February at the end of the registration period.

(2) Biennial registration is valid for a two-year period. The period starts on the day a vehicle is registered and runs through the same day two years later. Once a vehicle is registered under biennial registration, the registration period of the vehicle begins and ends with that same day each time the vehicle is reregistered or registration for the vehicle is renewed. Vehicles initially registered on February 29 will expire on the last day of February two years later.

(3) Calendar-year registration starts on January 1 of a year and runs through December 31 of the same year.

(4) Ownership registration starts on the day the vehicle is registered and is valid until the ownership of the vehicle changes.

(5) Permanent registration starts on the day the vehicle is registered and is valid for the life of the vehicle.

(6) Quarterly registration starts on the first day of any calendar quarter and runs through the last day of the last calendar quarter in the registration period. The number of calendar quarters in a quarterly registration is elected by the vehicle owner at the time of registration. A person may not establish quarterly registration periods for more than four quarters. If a vehicle is registered for a quarterly registration period of less than four calendar quarters, the Department of Transportation shall collect, when issuing or renewing registration of the vehicle, the additional fee for quarterly registration established under ORS 803.420.

(7) Four-year registration starts on the day a vehicle is registered and runs through the same day four years later.

SECTION 15. Sections 2 to 4 of this 2011 Act and the amendments to ORS 801.041, 801.042, 803.350, 803.400, 803.415, 803.420, 805.103, 805.105 and 805.110 by sections 5 to 14 of this 2011 Act apply to motor vehicle registrations issued or renewed on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.
