4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 498.
5	SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of ORS 480.110 to 480.165 and to the extent
6	allowable under federal law, a person who holds the appropriate licenses and tags under the
7	wildlife laws may use noisemakers to nonlethally deter pinnipeds from damaging fishing gear
8	or catch.
9	(2) The State Fish and Wildlife Commission may adopt rules necessary to carry out the
10	provisions of subsection (1) of this section.
11	SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 509.
12	SECTION 4. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of ORS 480.110 to 480.165 and to the extent
13	allowable under federal law, a person who holds the appropriate licenses and tags under the
14	commercial fishing laws may use noisemakers to nonlethally deter pinnipeds from damaging
15	fishing gear or catch.
16	(2) The State Fish and Wildlife Commission may adopt rules necessary to carry out the
17	provisions of subsection (1) of this section.
