SUMMARY

Creates exemption from state preemption for local laws designed to prevent or control presence of pesticides in potable water.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to local laws regulating pesticides.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 634.

5 SECTION 2. This chapter does not limit the authority of a city, town, county or other

6 political subdivision of this state to adopt or enforce a local ordinance, rule or regulation for

7 the purpose of preventing or controlling the presence of pesticides in surface and ground

8 water used by the city, town, county or political subdivision as a source of potable water.
