Directs Chief Justice of the Supreme Court to develop criteria and process for identifying and expediting major civil actions.

- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court shall develop criteria for identifying major civil actions based on whether the pleadings in the action request for relief that, if ordered, would have a very significant impact on public bodies as defined in ORS 174.109, businesses in this state or the public generally.
 - (2) The Chief Justice shall develop a process for expediting major civil actions identified under this section. The process shall include:
 - (a) Expedited motion and hearing dates in circuit courts;
 - (b) Priority on the trial docket of circuit courts;
 - (c) Expedited motion and hearing dates in appellate courts; and
 - (d) Certification of appeals to the Supreme Court under ORS 19.405 in appropriate circumstances.
 - (3) Any person filing a civil action who believes that the action qualifies as a major civil action under the criteria developed under this section shall include, in the caption of the pleading initiating the action, a notation that the action is a major civil action. As soon as possible after filing the pleading, the person must file a motion with the circuit court seeking an order of the court finding that the civil action is a major civil action under the criteria developed under this section. If the circuit court orders that the civil action is a major civil action, the proceedings in the action are subject to the process developed under subsection (2) of this section.
