SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Authorizes Department of Corrections to charge and collect fees for serving process and other documents on inmates, officials and employees. Directs department to adopt rules establishing fee schedule. **Limits amount that may be charged under fee schedule.**

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Department of Corrections fees for service of documents; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Corrections may charge and collect fees for serving**
5 **process and other documents on inmates of Department of Corrections institutions as de-**
6 **finied in ORS 421.005 and officials and employees of the department.**

7 **(2) Before charging fees pursuant to subsection (1) of this section, the department shall**
8 **adopt rules establishing a fee schedule. Fees charged by the department may not exceed fees**
9 **collected by sheriffs for service of process in civil actions, suits and proceedings pursuant**
10 **to ORS 21.410.**

11 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
13 **on its passage.**
