

# House Bill 3307

Sponsored by Representative BERGER

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires local governments to allow siting of redemption center in certain cases.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to the siting of redemption centers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 197.**

5 **SECTION 2. A redemption center certified under ORS 459A.735 is a commercial use. A**  
6 **local government shall allow the siting of a redemption center on the same or substantially**  
7 **similar basis in areas planned or zoned for commercial use as the local government allows**  
8 **a place of business of a dealer of similar size that engages in the sale of beverages in**  
9 **beverage containers.**

10 **SECTION 3. A local government shall adopt changes, if necessary, to the acknowledged**  
11 **comprehensive plan or land use regulations to implement section 2 of this 2011 Act within**  
12 **six months after the effective date of this 2011 Act.**
