

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3335

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “Commission;” insert “creating new provisions;  
2 and”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 390.124 is amended to read:

5 “390.124. (1) In accordance with any applicable provision of ORS chapter 183, the State Parks  
6 and Recreation Commission may adopt rules necessary to carry out the duties, functions and powers  
7 imposed by law upon the commission and the State Parks and Recreation Department. Rules adopted  
8 pursuant to this section shall be duly entered in the minutes and records of the commission.

9 “(2)(a) The commission may adopt rules that assess reasonable **fees and** charges[, *including fee*  
10 *reductions, waivers and exemptions,*] for the use of areas established and maintained by the depart-  
11 ment. **The commission may also adopt rules establishing reductions in, waivers of or ex-**  
12 **emptions from the fees and charges.** [*However,*] The commission shall authorize the use of any  
13 state park, individual campsite or day use fee area without charge:

14 “[a] (A) Upon the showing of proper identification, by a person maintaining a foster home, as  
15 defined by ORS 418.625, and the person’s children, when accompanied by a foster child residing in  
16 the home.

17 “[b] (B) Upon the showing of proper identification, by a person maintaining a developmental  
18 disability child foster home, as defined by ORS 443.830, and the person’s children, when accompanied  
19 by a foster child residing in the home.

20 “[c] (C) If a deed to, lease of or contract to use the property used as a state park, campsite  
21 or day use fee area prohibits the charging of fees for use of the property.

22 “[d] (D) Upon the showing of proper identification, by either a disabled veteran or a person  
23 on leave from military active duty status on Memorial Day, Independence Day or Veterans Day.

24 “(b)(A) **The rules described in paragraph (a) of this subsection establishing reductions in,**  
25 **waivers of or exemptions from fees and charges may include reductions in, waivers of or**  
26 **exemptions from fees and charges for Oregon armed services members returning from**  
27 **overseas combat zone deployment, or being honorably discharged from active overseas com-**  
28 **bat zone deployment, in order to honor and benefit these armed services members. Any re-**  
29 **ductions in, waivers of or exemptions from fees and charges provided under this paragraph**  
30 **must be limited to not more than a total of 10 consecutive days and:**

31 “(i) **Must be for use of areas established and maintained by the department that takes**  
32 **place within the first 90 days of the armed services member’s return from overseas combat**  
33 **zone deployment or honorable discharge from active overseas combat zone deployment; or**

34 “(ii) **Must be for reservations for the use of areas established and maintained by the de-**  
35 **partment made within the first 90 days of the armed services member’s return from overseas**

1 **combat zone deployment or honorable discharge from active overseas combat zone deploy-**  
2 **ment.**

3 **“(B) In implementing the provisions of this paragraph, the commission may:**

4 **“(i) Require that armed services members being honorably discharged from active over-**  
5 **seas combat zone deployment present discharge papers before using areas established and**  
6 **maintained by the department.**

7 **“(ii) Work with the Oregon National Guard to identify armed services members who have**  
8 **returned from overseas combat zone deployment.**

9 **“(3) The commission shall report to an appropriate committee of the Legislative Assembly, no**  
10 **later than January 31 of each odd-numbered year, on the [*fee reductions, waivers and exemptions***  
11 ***adopted by rule by the commission*] **reductions in, waivers of or exemptions from fees and****  
12 **charges established by rule pursuant to subsection (2) of this section.**

13 **“SECTION 2. ORS 390.124 (2)(b) applies to Oregon armed services members returning**  
14 **from overseas combat zone deployment, or being honorably discharged from active overseas**  
15 **combat zone deployment, on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.”.**

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
