SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires state institutions of higher learning to allow military recruitment on campus on equal footing with other employment recruitment. Requires nonstate institutions of higher learning that accept state educational assistance to allow military recruitment on campus.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to campus military recruitment.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 **<u>SECTION 1.</u>** (1) As used in this section:

5 (a) "Nonstate institution of higher learning" means an Oregon-based, generally accred-

6 ited, not-for-profit private institution of higher education.

7 (b) "State institution of higher learning" means:

- 8 (A) A state institution of higher education listed in ORS 352.002;
- 9 (B) A community college operated under ORS chapter 341; and

10 (C) Oregon Health and Science University.

(2) A state institution of higher learning shall allow members and agents of the Armed
Forces of the United States to recruit on a public campus and shall set rules and standards
for such recruitment that are the same as for all other employment recruitment activities
allowed on the campus.

(3) A nonstate institution of higher learning may not receive state funding for any educational activities or assistance unless the institution allows members and agents of the Armed Forces of the United States to recruit on its campus under rules and standards for such recruitment that are the same as for all other employment recruitment activities allowed on the campus.
