SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Provides that U.S. Highway 30 between St. Helens and Rainier shall be known as **Police** Chief Ralph Painter Memorial Highway.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to U.S. Highway 30. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. (1) The portion of U.S. Highway 30, known as the Lower Columbia River Highway, beginning in St. Helens and ending in Rainier, shall also be known as Police Chief 5 Ralph Painter Memorial Highway. 6 (2) The Department of Transportation shall place and maintain suitable markers along 7 8 the highway described in this section indicating the designation of the highway as the Police Chief Ralph Painter Memorial Highway. 9 10
