## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Provides that U.S. Highway 30 between St. Helens and Rainier shall be known as Chief Ralph Painter Memorial Highway.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to U.S. Highway 30. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. (1) The portion of U.S. Highway 30, known as the Lower Columbia River 4 Highway, beginning in St. Helens and ending in Rainier, shall also be known as the Chief 5 6 Ralph Painter Memorial Highway. 7 (2) The Department of Transportation shall place and maintain suitable markers along the highway described in this section indicating the designation of the highway as the Chief 8 9 Ralph Painter Memorial Highway.
