## House Bill 3357

Sponsored by Representative BERGER; Representative OLSON, Senator GEORGE

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires Secretary of State to adopt rule related to upcoming election not later than 90 days after law requiring rule becomes operative.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 246.150 is amended to read:
5	246.150. (1) The Secretary of State may adopt rules the secretary considers necessary to facili
6	tate and assist in achieving and maintaining a maximum degree of correctness, impartiality and ef
7	ficiency in administration of the election laws.
8	(2) The Secretary of State shall adopt any rule that is related to or will affect an up
9	coming election not later than 90 days after the law requiring the rule becomes operative.
10	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 246.150 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to laws
11	that become operative on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.
