

House Bill 3357

Sponsored by Representative BERGER; Representative OLSON, Senator GEORGE

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Secretary of State to adopt rule related to upcoming election not later than 90 days after law requiring rule becomes operative.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to administrative rules; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 246.150.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 246.150 is amended to read:

5 246.150. (1) The Secretary of State may adopt rules the secretary considers necessary to facili-
6 tate and assist in achieving and maintaining a maximum degree of correctness, impartiality and ef-
7 ficiency in administration of the election laws.

8 **(2) The Secretary of State shall adopt any rule that is related to or will affect an up-**
9 **coming election not later than 90 days after the law requiring the rule becomes operative.**

10 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 246.150 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to laws
11 that become operative on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.
