

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3362

1 On page 3 of the printed bill, line 15, after “(5)” insert “(a)” and delete the boldfaced material.

2 In lines 16 and 17, delete the boldfaced material.

3 After line 17, insert:

4 “(b) For a public charter school that provides educational services under a cooperative agree-  
5 ment described in section 2 of this 2011 Act, the public charter school is in compliance with the  
6 requirements of this subsection if the public charter school provides educational services under the  
7 cooperative agreement to at least 25 students, without regard to the school districts in which the  
8 students are residents.”.

9 On page 4, line 38, after “(5)” insert “(a)” and delete the boldfaced material.

10 In lines 39 and 40, delete the boldfaced material.

11 After line 40, insert:

12 “(b) For a public charter school that provides educational services under a cooperative agree-  
13 ment described in section 2 of this 2011 Act, the public charter school is in compliance with the  
14 requirements of this subsection if the public charter school provides educational services under the  
15 cooperative agreement to at least 25 students, without regard to the school districts in which the  
16 students are residents.”.

17 On page 6, delete lines 1 through 23 and insert:

18 “**SECTION 7. (1) The Career and Technical Education Revitalization Grant Program is**  
19 **established within the Department of Education.**

20 “**(2) Subject to the availability of funds, the department shall award grants each biennium**  
21 **to school districts, education service districts, public schools or public charter schools, or**  
22 **any combination thereof, for the uses described in subsection (3) of this section.**

23 “**(3) Grants received under this section must be used to enhance the collaboration be-**  
24 **tween education providers and employers by:**

25 “**(a) Developing or enhancing career and technical education programs of study;**

26 “**(b) Expanding the professional growth of and career opportunities for students through**  
27 **career and technical education programs;**

28 “**(c) Assessing the ability of each career and technical education program to meet**  
29 **workforce needs and give students the skills required for jobs in this state that provide high**  
30 **wages and are in high demand; and**

31 “**(d) Supporting the achievement of the high school diploma requirements established**  
32 **under ORS 329.451.**

33 “**(4) Any school district, education service district, public school or public charter school,**  
34 **or any combination thereof, may apply for a grant under this section.**

35 “**(5)(a) The department shall award grants based on the ability of the applicant to use a**

1 grant as described in subsection (3) of this section.

2 “(b) In addition to the requirement of paragraph (a) of this subsection, the department  
3 shall give priority to:

4 “(A) Awarding grants to applicants so that the grants awarded represent a diverse  
5 number of students served and a diverse selection of geographic locations; and

6 “(B) Applicants that have received commitments from business, industry, labor or edu-  
7 cation providers to enhance collaboration and to provide resources for any collaborative ef-  
8 forts.

9 “(c) For the purpose of awarding grants, the department shall jointly convene with the  
10 Bureau of Labor and Industries a committee that represents business, industry, labor and  
11 education providers for the purpose of reviewing applications for grants and recommending  
12 determinations on the applications.

13 “(6) The State Board of Education may adopt any rules necessary for the implementation  
14 of this section.”.

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
