## House Bill 3370

Sponsored by Representative BARKER (at the request of Superintendent of Public Instruction Susan Castillo, Oregon School Boards Association, Confederation of School Administrators, Oregon Education Association, AFT-Oregon, Oregon School Employees Association)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires preparation of fiscal impact statements in cases where proposed legislative measure imposes new duty or increased level of service on school districts or education service districts.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to legislative impact statements; amending ORS 173.025.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 173.025 is amended to read:

5 173.025. (1) The Legislative Fiscal Officer, with the aid of the Oregon Department of Adminis-

6 trative Services, the Legislative Revenue Officer, state agencies and affected local governmental

7 units, including school districts and education service districts, shall prepare a fiscal impact

8 statement on each measure reported out of a committee of the Legislative Assembly that could have

9 an effect on expenditures of local governmental units, including school districts and education

## 10 service districts.

(2) The Legislative Revenue Officer, with the aid of the Legislative Fiscal Officer, the Department of Revenue, state agencies and affected local governmental units, including school districts and education service districts, shall prepare a revenue impact statement on each measure reported out of a committee of the Legislative Assembly that could have any effect on revenues of local governmental units, including school districts and education service districts.

(3) In addition to fiscal impact statements prepared under subsection (1) of this section,
a fiscal impact statement setting forth the effect of the measure on expenditures shall be
prepared if a measure imposes a new duty or increased level of service on a school district
or education service district.
