## House Bill 3378

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires Department of Environmental Quality to study issues related to compliance with terms and conditions of permits issued by department.

Sunsets January 2, 2014.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to the Department of Environmental Quality.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. The Department of Environmental Quality shall undertake a study of issues related to compliance with the terms and conditions of permits issued by the department, including but not limited to those permits whose holders seek to renew the permit, or to apply for another permit from the department, when the holder is not in compliance with all the terms and conditions of the permit. The department shall provide data regarding the department's modification, suspension, revocation, refusal to issue or refusal to renew permits pursuant to ORS 468.070. The department shall report the results of the study to the Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly by March 1, 2013.
- SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act is repealed on January 2, 2014.
