

House Bill 3378

Sponsored by Representative BARNHART

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Environmental Quality to study issues related to compliance with terms and conditions of permits issued by department.

Sunsets January 2, 2014.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the Department of Environmental Quality.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Environmental Quality shall undertake a study of issues**
5 **related to compliance with the terms and conditions of permits issued by the department,**
6 **including but not limited to those permits whose holders seek to renew the permit, or to**
7 **apply for another permit from the department, when the holder is not in compliance with**
8 **all the terms and conditions of the permit. The department shall provide data regarding the**
9 **department's modification, suspension, revocation, refusal to issue or refusal to renew per-**
10 **mits pursuant to ORS 468.070. The department shall report the results of the study to the**
11 **Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly by March 1, 2013.**

12 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act is repealed on January 2, 2014.**
