House Bill 3382

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires long term care facilities and residential facilities to provide same-gender care if required by physician order.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to same-gender care provided in residential settings; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 441.015 to
5	441.063.
6	SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "same-gender care" means assistance with
7	bathing, dressing, grooming and other intimate personal care that is provided to a patient
8	by a staff member who is the same gender as the patient.
9	(2) A long term care facility must comply with a physician's order to provide same-
10	gender care.
11	SECTION 3. Section 4 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 443.400 to
12	443.455.
13	SECTION 4. (1) As used in this section, "same-gender care" means assistance with
14	bathing, dressing, grooming and other intimate personal care that is provided to a resident
15	by a staff member who is the same gender as the resident.
16	(2) A residential facility must comply with a physician's order to provide same-gender
17	care.
18	SECTION 5. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
19	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
