

House Bill 3402

Sponsored by Representative HUNT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires each school district, education service district and public charter school to adopt policy related to employees wearing religious clothing while performing official duties.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to employees wearing religious clothing; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Each school district, education service district and public charter school**
5 **shall adopt a policy related to employees wearing religious clothing while performing official**
6 **duties. The policy must be consistent with the provisions of ORS 659A.033 and any rules**
7 **adopted by the Bureau of Labor and Industries.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
10 **July 1, 2011.**
