## House Bill 3402

Sponsored by Representative HUNT

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires each school district, education service district and public charter school to adopt policy related to employees wearing religious clothing while performing official duties. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2011.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to employees wearing religious clothing; and declaring an emergency.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Each school district, education service district and public charter school

5 shall adopt a policy related to employees wearing religious clothing while performing official

6 duties. The policy must be consistent with the provisions of ORS 659A.033 and any rules

7 adopted by the Bureau of Labor and Industries.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 9 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 10 July 1, 2011.
