

House Bill 3410

Sponsored by Representative G SMITH

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates special military hunting season to allow service members to hunt deer and elk during specified period.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to special military hunting season.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "service member" means a person who:**

5 **(a) Is an active duty member of the Armed Forces of the United States and includes a**
6 **member of the Oregon National Guard serving on active duty under Title 32 of the United**
7 **States Code; and**

8 **(b) Has been a resident of Oregon for at least six consecutive months prior to application**
9 **for a license.**

10 **(2) There is created a special military hunting season to allow service members to hunt**
11 **deer and elk.**

12 **(3) The State Fish and Wildlife Commission is authorized to issue, upon application by**
13 **the service member and at no cost to the service member, a special military hunting season**
14 **license.**

15 **(4) The license allows a service member to hunt deer and elk from August 1 through**
16 **March 31 of the following year.**

17 **(5) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a service member issued a special mili-**
18 **tary hunting season license must comply with all laws and rules pertaining to tags and per-**
19 **mits required for the hunting of deer and elk.**

20 **(6) The commission shall adopt rules necessary to carry out the provisions of this sec-**
21 **tion.**
