HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3474

1	On page 4 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 5, delete "State Board of Education" and insert
2	"Teacher Standards and Practices Commission".
3	Delete lines 33 through 45 and delete <u>page 5</u> and insert:
4	" <u>SECTION 9.</u> (1) As used in this section, 'Oregon Coalition for Quality Teaching and
5	Learning' means the collaborative group of state, school district, educator, administrator,
6	community and higher education representatives operating as a unit organized under the
7	National Commission on Teaching and America's Future.
8	"(2) The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission and the Department of Education,
9	working with the Oregon Coalition for Quality Teaching and Learning, shall propose guide-
10	lines to adopt a uniform set of model core teaching standards for teaching preparation, new
11	teachers and experienced teachers that align with updated national teaching standards. The
12	guidelines must allow the standards to be customized based on the collaborative efforts of
13	the teachers and administrators of the school district and the exclusive bargaining repre-
14	sentative of the employees of the school district.
15	"(3) The guidelines must propose model core teaching standards that:
16	"(a) Are research-based;
17	"(b) Distinguish different levels of proficiency; and
18	"(c) Include multiple measures of student growth and achievement using student, school
19	and school district data.
20	"(4) The commission and the department shall report to the Legislative Assembly prior
21	to January 1, 2012, on the proposed guidelines for model core teaching standards.
22	"(5) The commission shall adopt and distribute the model core teaching standards to
23	school districts on or before March 1, 2012.
24	"(6) All school districts shall begin using the model core teaching standards in annual
25	evaluations of teachers beginning in the 2012-2013 school year.
26	"SECTION 10. (1) As used in this section, 'Oregon Coalition for Quality Teaching and
27	Learning' means the collaborative group of state, school district, educator, administrator,
28	community and higher education representatives operating as a unit organized under the
29	National Commission on Teaching and America's Future.
30	"(2) The Teacher Standards and Practices Commission and the Department of Education,
31	working with the Oregon Coalition for Quality Teaching and Learning, shall prepare a plan
32	to encourage national board certification for teachers and administrators.
33	"(3) The plan must address the costs of applying for certification, providing preparation
34	support for applicants and a strategy for providing bonuses for nationally board certified

35 teachers and administrators.

1 "(4) Moneys from the National Board Certification Fund may be used to prepare the plan.

2 "SECTION 11. Sections 8, 9 and 10 of this 2011 Act are repealed on March 2, 2013.

3 "<u>SECTION 12.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-

4 priated to the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission, for the biennium beginning July

5 1, 2011, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$100,000, for deposit in the Educator Prepa-

6 ration Improvement Fund created under section 2 of this 2011 Act.

⁷ "SECTION 13. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
⁸ peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect
⁹ on its passage.".

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
