SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Military Department to report to legislative committee on existing military cultural barriers that discourage service members from identifying barriers to reintegration into civilian life. Directs department to report on proposed legislation for eliminating barriers by October 1, 2014.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the Oregon Military Department; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. On or before October 1 of each even-numbered year, the Oregon Military**
5 **Department shall report to a legislative committee dealing with the military on the existing**
6 **military cultural barriers that discourage service members from identifying their medical,**
7 **emotional, psychological and other barriers to reintegration into civilian life.**

8 **SECTION 2. On or before October 1, 2014, the Oregon Military Department shall report**
9 **to a legislative committee dealing with the military on proposed legislation to eliminate the**
10 **military cultural barriers that discourage service members from identifying their medical,**
11 **emotional, psychological and other barriers to reintegration into civilian life.**

12 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is repealed on January 1, 2015.**

13 **SECTION 4. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
15 **on its passage.**
