## House Bill 3514

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Prescribes treatments that must be covered by health benefit plans for traumatic brain injuries. Applies to health benefit plans in effect on or after effective date of Act.

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. ORS 743A.175 is amended to read:
6	743A.175. (1) A health benefit plan, as defined in ORS 743.730, shall provide coverage of med-
7	ically necessary treatment, rehabilitation and therapy [and services] for [the treatment of] trau-
8	matic brain [injury] injuries including, but not limited to:
9	(a) Cognitive rehabilitation therapy;
10	(b) Cognitive communication therapy;
11	(c) Neurocognitive therapy and rehabilitation;
12	(d) Neurobehavioral, neurophysiological, neuropsychological or psychophysiological test-
13	ing or treatment;
14	(e) Vision therapy, neuro-optometry therapy and rehabilitation;
15	(f) Remediation;
16	(g) Post-acute transition services; and
17	(h) Community reintegration services necessary as a result of and related to an acquired
18	brain injury.
19	(2) This section is exempt from ORS 743A.001.
20	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 743A.175 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to
21	health benefit plans in effect on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.

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
