House Bill 3524

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Reduces amount of general purpose grant for school district that does not maximize rate of allowable taxes dedicated to funding public schools.

2	Relating to public school funding.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 327.006 to
5	327.133.
6	SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 327.013, the amount a school district receives as a
7	general purpose grant under ORS 327.013 shall be reduced by the difference of:
8	(a) The total amount of property taxes that the school district could receive for public
9	schools, based on the maximum rate of allowable taxes dedicated to funding the public school
10	system under section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution; and
11	(b) The total amount of property taxes that the school district actually receives for public
12	schools, including penalties and interest on taxes.
13	(2) Any amounts retained as provided by subsection (1) of this section shall be prorated
14	and distributed to school districts that did not have the general purpose grant of the school
15	district reduced as provided by subsection (1) of this section.

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
