

House Bill 3527

Sponsored by Representative J SMITH

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to determine cost of each grid block classification within sentencing guidelines grid established by rules of commission. Requires commission to make available at time of sentencing, to sentencing court, district attorney and defendant, risk score applicable to defendant as determined by Public Safety Checklist for Oregon and cost of each grid block on criminal history scale applicable to defendant on each count.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to sentencing; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall determine the cost of**
5 **each grid block classification within the sentencing guidelines grid established by the rules**
6 **of the commission.**

7 **(2) At the time of sentencing, the commission shall make available to the sentencing**
8 **court, the district attorney and the defendant:**

9 **(a) The risk score applicable to the defendant as determined by the commission's Public**
10 **Safety Checklist for Oregon; and**

11 **(b) The cost of each grid block on the criminal history scale applicable to the defendant**
12 **on each count as determined pursuant to subsection (1) of this section.**

13 **(3) The commission shall adopt rules to implement the provisions of this section.**

14 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
16 **on its passage.**
