2 Relating to wolves.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Subject to and consistent with the federal Endangered Species Act of 1973

5 (P.L. 93-205, 16 U.S.C. 1531 et seq.) as in effect on the effective date of this 2011 Act, and

6 notwithstanding any provision of ORS 496.171 to 496.182, a person may take a gray wolf in

7 defense of the person's own life or the life of another person.
