A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to wolves.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 498.

5 SECTION 2. (1) A person may take a gray wolf without cause and without a permit from

6 the State Fish and Wildlife Commission if the gray wolf is within 500 feet of the residence

7 of the person.

8 (2) A person may take a gray wolf without a permit from the commission if the gray wolf

9 is chasing, harassing, wounding or biting livestock, pets, working dogs or sporting dogs.
