House Bill 3567

Sponsored by Representative HARKER; Representatives HUFFMAN, NATHANSON, J SMITH

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Oregon Department of Administrative Services to conduct assessment of state's desktop computers and mobile workstations. Requires department to determine whether consolidation of acquisition, management and support of state's desktop computers and mobile workstations is feasible. Directs department to develop plan for consolidation if department determines that consolidation is feasible. Requires report to Legislative Assembly.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to information technology; and declaring an emergency.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) As soon as possible after the effective date of this 2011 Act, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall conduct an assessment of the state's desktop computers and mobile workstations. The assessment must include:
 - (a) An inventory and evaluation of the state's desktop computers and mobile workstations:
 - (b) An evaluation of the ongoing costs of operating these assets;
 - (c) An evaluation of problems and challenges in managing these assets; and
 - (d) The identification of potential improvements in the manner in which these assets are managed.
 - (2) As soon as possible after conducting the assessment required by subsection (1) of this section, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall determine whether the consolidation of the acquisition, management and support of the state's desktop computers and mobile workstations is feasible. If the department determines that the consolidation is feasible, the department shall develop a plan for accomplishing the consolidation that addresses hardware and software acquisition, management of assets, and support. In developing the plan, the department shall consider:
 - (a) A governance structure for the consolidation and management of the shared service workstation environment;
 - (b) The consolidation of directories;
 - (c) The consolidation of electronic mail systems and administration;
 - (d) A centralized help desk; and
 - (e) The standardization of desktop productivity tools and operating systems.
 - (3) As part of any plan developed under subsection (2) of this section, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall assess the cost savings, cost avoidance and efficiencies that could be derived from the consolidation of the acquisition, management and support of the state's desktop computers and mobile workstations, including savings attrib-

(4) Not later than February 1, 2012, the Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall prepare and submit a report to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 on the assessment required by subsection (1) of this section and on any plan developed under subsection (2) of this section.

SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect on its passage.
