

# House Bill 3576

Sponsored by Representative HOLVEY

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Secretary of State to consider location of voter registration of candidate for office of state Representative or state Senator for purpose of determining whether candidate is inhabitant of district as required by Oregon Constitution.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to candidacy for state legislative office.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 249.**

5 **SECTION 2. For purposes of determining whether a candidate for the office of state**  
6 **Representative or state Senator has been an inhabitant of the district from which the Sen-**  
7 **ator or Representative may be chosen as required by section 8, Article IV of the Oregon**  
8 **Constitution, the Secretary of State shall consider the district in which the candidate is**  
9 **registered to vote as evidence of whether the candidate is an inhabitant of the district.**
