## House Bill 3603

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits cities from imposing franchise fees or privilege taxes on certain districts for occupancy of public streets or roads.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to franchise fees.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) As used in this section, "district" means any type of district listed in ORS 5 198.010.

6 (2) Notwithstanding ORS 221.420 or 221.450, a city may not impose a franchise fee, privi-

lege tax or other fee for occupancy of public streets or roads on any district that provides
services or has facilities within the boundaries of the city.
