SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Allows person that received waiver pursuant to Ballot Measure 37 (2005) claim to develop or use property pursuant to waiver if person expended more than \$400,000 completing or continuing use described by waiver.

Declaring emergency, effective on passage.

2	Relating to Ballot Measure 49 (2007) claims; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 195.305 to
5	195.336.
6	SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of the authority granted by section 5, chapter
7	424, Oregon Laws 2007, a claimant that filed a claim under ORS 195.305 on or before June 28
8	2007, is entitled to just compensation as provided in a waiver issued before December 6, 2007
9	to the extent that the claimant's use of the property complies with the waiver and the
10	claimant has expended more than \$400,000 to complete or continue the use described in the
11	waiver.
12	SECTION 3. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
13	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effec
14	on its passage.
