House Bill 3633

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Department of Human Services to establish licensing system for persons who refer residents to certain care facilities in exchange for compensation.

Requires persons who refer residents to certain care facilities in exchange for compensation to obtain license from department.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to referrals to care facilities. 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section: 4 5 (a) "Facility" means: 6 (A) A residential facility as defined in ORS 443.400; 7 (B) A long term care facility as defined in ORS 442.015; or (C) An adult foster home as defined in ORS 443.705. 9 (b) "Resident" means a person receiving care in a facility. 10 (2) The Department of Human Services shall adopt rules establishing a licensing system 11 for persons who refer residents to facilities in exchange for compensation. 12 (3) A person may not refer a resident to a facility in exchange for compensation unless 13 the person is licensed by the department pursuant to subsection (2) of this section.

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
