

# House Bill 3635

Sponsored by Representative OLSON

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Clarifies language concerning persons employed on farms who are exempt from payment of overtime wages.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to persons employed in certain facilities located on farms; amending ORS 653.265.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 653.265 is amended to read:

5 653.265. [*When*] (1) **Persons** employed in canneries, [*or*] driers or packing plants[, *excluding*  
6 *canneries or driers or packing plants located on farms and primarily processing products produced on*  
7 *such farms, employees*] shall be paid time and a half for time over 10 hours per day and piece  
8 workers shall be paid one and a half the regular prices for all work done during the time they are  
9 employed over 10 hours per day.

10 (2) **Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to employees of canneries, driers or**  
11 **packing plants located on farms that are the single largest supplier, by volume or value, of**  
12 **products processed by the cannery, drier or packing plant.**
