SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Adjutant General to form commission to develop and name medal to honor fallen military members from Oregon. Directs commission to present medal design to Governor for approval.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the development of a medal to honor Oregon military members who have fallen in the 3 line of duty.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Adjutant General shall form a commission that includes the Adjutant 6 General, two Assistant Adjutants General and two veterans' service officers.

7 (2) The purpose of the commission is to develop and name a medal that will honor fallen 8 military members for the courage and sacrifice they have made for the State of Oregon. The 9 purpose of the medal is to honor the memory and sacrifice of military members from Oregon 10 who were killed in action or who died as a result of wounds received in action, including 11 action in the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. The intent of the Legislative Assembly is to have 12 the medal be awarded to the fallen service members and be presented to the next of kin of 13 those military members.

(3) The commission shall design the medal and suggest an appropriate name for the medal and an appropriate ceremony for presentation of the medal to the next of kin. The name of the medal may not be the same as or similar to any military medal issued by the federal government.

(4) Upon completion of the design, the commission shall present the medal design to the
Governor, as Commander in Chief of the Oregon National Guard, for the Governor's approval.

(5) If the Governor approves, the Governor shall present the proposed medal to the
Seventy-seventh Legislative Assembly for its approval.
